



**BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR  
THE PROCUREMENT OF A CONSULTING FIRM FOR THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF MONITORING & EVALUATION SYSTEM FOR THE  
CLIMATE RESILIENT AND FARM PRODUCTIVITY SUPPORT (CRFPS)  
PROJECT**

**BAC Resolution No. 043B-2024-323**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Agrarian Reform Central Office (DARCO), through **Bureau of Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries Development (BARBD)**, and pursuant to the General Appropriations Act (FY 2024), intends to apply the sum of **Philippine Pesos Three Million Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 (Php 3,998,400.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Procurement of a Consulting Firm for the establishment of Monitoring & Evaluation System for the Climate Resilient and Farm Productivity Support (CRFPS) Project to track the progress of implementation and enable strategic decision-making toward the achievement of project goals and objectives;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC, through BAC Resolution No. 043B-2024-293 series of 2024, recommended to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) the approval of the final evaluation result (combined technical and financial evaluation rating) and the conduct of negotiation meeting with the Single Rated Bidder (SRB), (refer to Annex "A" copy of BAC Resolution No. 043B-2024-293 series of 2024);

**WHEREAS**, upon approval by the HOPE of the abovementioned BAC Resolution, the Bids and Awards Committee conducted a negotiation meeting with Geographic Innovations for Development Solutions, Inc. (GRIDS) on 17 December 2024, with the following clarifications/agreements:

1. The system developer's experience in M & E is related to agro-enterprise development;
2. On the maps in the system-there will be no additional charges for the maps to be used for the system's mapping feature;
3. On the system to be developed- data security is ensured with multiple back-ups (cloud and physical), data will not be lost when renewal of annual subscription is being done; no special hardware or software is required to access the system and produce reports;
4. Full turnover of the system, codes, and the process will be done through the manual to be developed by the consulting firm; and
5. After sales service-if there are still debugging required outside of the contract duration, the consulting firm shall perform it without additional cost to DAR.

**WHEREAS**, on the same date, the BAC instructed the Secretariat and the end-user representative to immediately proceed with the post-qualification process;

**WHEREAS**, on 19 December 2024, the BAC-Secretariat and the end-user representative conducted the post-qualification evaluation of GRIDS;

**WHEREAS**, on 23 December 2024, during the BAC Meeting, the Post-Qualification Report for the procurement of consulting services from a firm for the Establishment of Monitoring and Evaluation System for the Climate Resilient and Farm Productivity Support (CRFPS) Project was presented with the recommendation to declare GRIDS compliant with all the requirements of the bidding documents, thus, GRIDS was declared to be the Single Rated Responsive Bidder (SRRB) (refer to Annex "C" Post-qualification Evaluation Report);

**WHEREFORE**, above premises considered, the BAC resolves to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE) the award of contract for the **PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTING SERVICES FROM A FIRM FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MONITORING AND EVALUATION SYSTEM FOR THE CLIMATE RESILIENT FARM PRODUCTIVITY SUPPORT PROJECT (CRFPS) PROJECT to GEOGRAPHIC INNOVATIONS FOR DEVELOPMENT SOLUTIONS, INC.** for having the SRRB in the amount of **PHILIPPINE PESOS THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND and 00/100 (PHP 3,752,000.00) ONLY.**
